## Remarks

The training grant application submitted by the company is first routed to the training organisation for endorsement, before routing to SSG. Training organisation is responsible to submit the claim to SSG upon course completion. Upon approval of the claim, the course fee funding will be disbursed to the training organisation and Absentee Payroll funding, if applicable, will be disbursed to the company.
- Trainees under company-sponsored are unable to claim for Skills Future Credit.
- The sponsored company pays training organisation the unfunded portion of the course fees i.e. full course fee less course fee funding from SSG. The training grant application submitted by the company is first routed to the training organisation for endorsement, before routing to SSG. Training organisation is responsible to submit the claim to SSG upon course completion. ## Remarks
